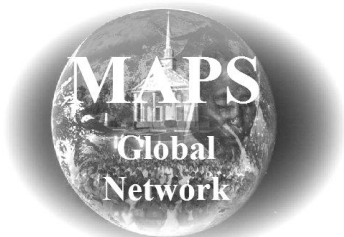
And Next...
